

**NANCY TAYLOR
DISTRICT TEN ENVIRONMENTAL AWARD**

CRITERIA

The Nancy Taylor District Ten Environmental Award will be presented annually to one Altrusa Club in District Ten. The Award is in honor of Nancy Taylor, District Ten Governor, 1991 - 1993, and her commitment to the environment.

Judging criteria will be as follows:

| 4. | Media attention directed to the project | 10% |

This award will be presented to the Altrusa Club which conducts an environmental project in its community and submits its presentation in a complete and timely manner. The focus of the project can be any facet of environmental improvement. Each club is encouraged to select a hands on project that meets the needs of its community and involves other clubs or organizations.

SUBMITTAL

Each club should submit a written entry (double spaced and typewritten) consisting of no more than 500 words. A cover page should include the following information:

Name of Club and City
Club Membership as of Date of Entry
Club President's Name, Address, and Telephone Number

The narrative should explain why the project was chosen, how it was executed, the percentage of members involved, other clubs who assisted, what made this project unique and any other pertinent information.

Samples of newspaper clippings should be limited to two pages (front and back). Audio cassettes of radio interviews and half-inch videotapes of television interviews may also be submitted.

The winning club will receive a cash award of \$50.00 plus interest earned on the corpus amount. Honorable mention certificates may be presented to the runners up at the judges' discretion. Administration of the funds and judging of the submittals will be conducted by Altrusa International of Clovis, New Mexico.

Entries shall be mailed to the President of Altrusa International of Clovis, New Mexico, c/o Nancy Taylor, 2522 West Seventh St., Clovis. NM 88101, for judging on or before the date established by the District Board for consideration in the District Competition.

JUDGING

Altrusa International of Clovis, New Mexico is to judge the entries and administer the funds for the Nancy Taylor Environmental Award. The original committee, consisting of at least four members, will serve until the first award has been presented at the District Conference. Three committee members will be replaced annually. Each outgoing member will have the opportunity to recommend a successor for appointment by the President. The fourth member will continue service on the committee for the second year and likewise make her replacement recommendation to the club president.

A minimum of \$50.00 will be awarded annually. Interest may be added at the committee's discretion. A maximum of \$100.00 can be presented.
